1995 Junior Subscription Fees

<i>Single</i>	(1 player)	\$35.00
<i>Family</i>	(2 or more)	\$55.00

You will have noticed that our club fees have increased for this season. Regrettably we have been forced to do this for two major reasons:

1. Soccer NZ (the new name for the NZ Football Association) has placed a \$5.00 + GST levy on all Junior players (the Seniors pay \$20.00 + GST). This levy will be used for the benefit of NZ soccer in many and varied areas.
2. The CJFA player levy is \$10.50 this season, an increase of \$1.00 per player.

So you can see that in spite of the \$5.00 increase in Junior subscriptions, the club will actually receive approximately \$1.65 less from each player.

We must pay the registration fee for each player to the CJFA (almost half your subscriptions) before he or she can legally play in any competition. So it is most important that subscriptions for juniors intending to play this season, have been paid before the commencement of competition.
